

Martha Retreat Centre 2023-2024: A Year of Growth and Gratitude

Did you know?

- **Over 5,000 Guests:** This year, over 5,200 guests visited the Centre, sharing in moments of peace and reflection.
- **Reaching Hearts Worldwide:** We sent 17,982 newsletters, keeping our community connected and informed.
- **Dedicated Support:** 87 volunteers and groups contributed their time and care to support our mission year-round.
- **Global Presence:** Our website saw visitors from 506 cities across Canada and around the world, reflecting our growing reach.

- **Generous Giving:** We are grateful for nearly 100 donors, including 21 who contribute monthly to sustain our programs.
- Engaging Events: Over the past year, we hosted more than 70 retreats and community gatherings, bringing 4,354 people together to explore peace, spirituality, and personal growth.
- **Community Connections:** The Centre also welcomed 27 external bookings with 483 attendees, building bridges with other groups.

The development of the Contemplative Food Garden over this last year has inspired hope in the fullness of its intention...from garden, to table, to soul. Sponsorship engagement and volunteer efforts have impacted the lives of over 300 people. We have served fresh produce to program guests, we have sold produce to 30 supporters and we contributed over 430 pounds of fresh produce to local food banks.


Impact! This little gem on the edge of the coulees is a magnificent gift to all those who come. Together, we will pave the way for ourselves and our future guests.
